Gregory Garrett passed away in the early morning hours on December 26, 2024 after a long illness. Greg loved people. His generous spirit and easy laughter endeared him to all who knew him. A master storyteller and lover of adventure, Greg had the ability to find humor in every situation. His kindness and intuitiveness about people elevated a simple conversation to a memorable event. Born in Harrisonburg, Virginia, Greg grew up in Falls Church, Virginia. In 1970, his family moved to Manassas. Greg is a 1972 graduate of Osbourn High School. Greg was preceded in death by his parents, George Garrett and Betty Hoskins. He is survived by his wife of 45 years, Toni Udell Garrett, one sister (Georgia) and a brother (Shay). He is also survived by two aunts Elouise Garrett of Boise, Idaho and Diane Hoskins (Ronnie) of Jefferson, North Carolina, as well as several cousins. Additionally, Greg is survived by sister-in-law Karen Udell Parker (Harry), a niece and nephew. Following 25 years of service to the citizens of the Commonwealth of Virginia, Greg retired from the Prince William County Police Department as a Master Detective in 2000. During his career with the police department, he served first as a dispatcher, then patrol officer, school resource officer and finally master detective investigating among other areas crimes against children. Greg and his wife, Toni, spent decades raising and showing Clydesdales. At one time, they cared for as many as 26 horses. Over the years, they adopted and spoiled a menagerie of well-loved dogs and cats. Their love and respect for animals was often at the center of conversation.

Greg's legacy will no doubt be his service to his community and his love for the people around him.
