Gwynneth Dolores Harris 88, of Clifton VA passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her family on Wednesday, June 27, 2018.

Born on January 3, 1930 in March, England she was the daughter of the late John Rogers and Elizabeth Rogers.

Gwynneth was the beloved wife of the late Charles Edward Harris who passed away on October 22, 2001. Gwynneth and her family moved around as Charles was enlisted in the Air Force before settling in Fairfax County, VA in 1969.
