



Harvey Stollenwerk

December 3, 1935 - July 23, 2015

Harvey Stollenwerk, born December 3, 1935 in Pasadena CA, was a lifelong Californian. He was the middle of 5 children, and grew up in Alhambra, and then in Lancaster. He is predeceased by his older brothers Fred and Tom, and survived by his younger siblings Teresa Matay and Roger.

He worked many jobs during his early life, including working on the family ranch, driving school busses, and at a furniture store in Lancaster. He graduated from Antelope Valley Junior College in 1955, and afterwards he worked at Edwards AFB for Douglas Aircraft. He met Nadine Rae Counsell Casteel in November 1956, and they married on June 22, 1957.

He graduated from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo in 1959. At Cal Poly, he was a member of the first pledge class of the Alpha Upsilon (now a part of Delta Upsilon) fraternity. As a senior, he was elected to the Board of Directors for the chapter.

After graduation, he worked for the Department of the Navy as a civilian, eventually rising to be Branch Head of the Applications Software Development Branch at Naval Weapons Assessment Center (NWAC), Corona, CA.

Harvey and Nadine raised three children, Edward (deceased), Daniel and Mary. They enjoyed hosting family get-togethers, and hosted Thanksgiving for the larger Stollenwerk family at their Riverside home for many years. Daniel is now married to the former Karan Turpin, and Mary is married to Shep Matthesen. Mary and Shep have four children Samantha, James, Katherine and Elizabeth.

Harvey retired from federal civil service in 1991, and during his retirement, he and his wife focused on traveling somewhere every month with at least one big trip each year. Their favorite trips were to Las Vegas and Laughlin NV, and Pala CA.

He was a long time member of St. Catherine of Alexandria parish in Riverside California. He played the ukulele, worked the hard crossword puzzles in the paper, enjoyed playing poker machines, supported Boy Scouts, bowled competitively in leagues and tournaments, and in younger days, took the family tent camping in National Parks, especially Yosemite and Lake Tahoe. He always had tic-tacs and a pencil in his pocket.

Harvey and Nadine celebrated their 58th wedding anniversary on June 22, 2015.

He passed away July 23, 2015, following several years of illness.
