Hector Amado Quinteros, aged 71 of Manassas, Virginia passed away on March 20, 2021. He was born to the late Amadeo Quinteros and Zoila Esperanza Alegria de Quinteros on September 3rd, 1949 in San Salvador, El Salvador and is preceded in death by his two brothers, Oscar Quinteros and Francisco Quinteros. He fought a brave battle with pancreatic cancer and departed this earthly life surrounded by his loving family.
