



Henrietta Webb Knecht

June 17, 1931 - February 11, 2015

Henrietta Webb Knecht passed away on February 11, 2015. She was 83 years old.

Henrietta was the daughter of the late Harry Clyde and Henrietta Geety Webb of Camp Hill, PA. She was born in Harrisburg, PA on June 17, 1931 and raised in Camp Hill, PA. Prior to 2006, she resided in Abington Township, PA and then moved to Manassas, VA.

Henrietta graduated from Camp Hill High School in 1949 and Penn State University in June 1953 with a BS in Education and later earned her MA in Education from Trenton State in NJ. She taught 3rd and 5th grades in the Upper Moreland School District for 22 years retiring in 1993.

Henrietta was an active member of the Willow Grove Methodist Church, the William Penn Chapter of DAR, and the SPCA. She was a volunteer for Aides for Friends, Hanna's Sisters, and at the Abington Memorial Hospital.

Henrietta was the wife of the late George Knecht and a devoted mother to Scott S. Dotterer, III of Tokyo, Japan and Susanna E. Lipscomb of Warrenton, VA and a deceased son, Charles Henry Dotterer. She was a loving grandmother to Thomas Henry Lipscomb. She was preceded in death by her sister Mary Jane Webb (Ployer) Cooper and survived by her brother, Charles Webb of Cambridge, MA, three nieces, and many friends and loved ones.
