HORACE SAMUEL "ANDY" ANDERSON, age 79 of Jefferson City, Tennessee, formerly of Manassas, Virginia died Tuesday, May 11, 2010.

Mr. Anderson was born December 26, 1930 in Corryton, Tennessee, son of the late John Newell and Elsie B. (Satterfield) Anderson. He was former member of Emmanuel Baptist Church, Manassas and a member of the Fleet Reserves Association. He was employed with the Central Intelligence Agency from 1983-1993 and had retired from the U. S.
