HORACE RAY MOODY, LT.COL. USAFR, age 82 of Nokesville, Virginia died Sunday, June 20, 2004 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas, Virginia.

Mr Moody was a Bombardier on a B-24 in the South Pacific during World War II. He was a member of Nokesville United Methodist Church, the B&B Square Dancing Club and the VFW in Clarkston, Washington. Mr. Moody was a volunteer for the Prince William County Library and the Halquist Memorial In Patient Center (Capital Hospice) in Arlington. Mr. Moody also had ridden all the major roller coasters in North America and Canada until the age of 80.
