Hugh Branson McDonald, age 76, of Manassas, died suddenly at his home on Tuesday, September 14, 2004 .

Mr. McDonald had retired from the U.S. Marshal Service after 24 years of service in 1982. He was involved in the implementation of the U.S. Marshal's Witness Protection Program. He was the first Inspector and had served as liaison between the U.S. Marshal office and the Organized Crime Division of the Justice Department. He was a lifetime member of the N.R.A.

Survivors include his wife of 37 years, Thelma Rae W. McDonald, Two Daughters: Kelly Rae McDonald of Fairfax, and Katherine Elizabeth McDonald Strich of Bristow and family.
