January 17, 1920 - November 18, 2009

Restored "Belle Grove" circa 1780, Paris, Virginia

HYLTON ELLIS WILKERSON, age 89 of Delaplane, Virginia passed away at Prince William Hospital Wednesday night November 18, 2009 with family by his side.

Hylton was born to a railroad fireman in the town of Monroe, Virginia in 1920 and grew up in Falls Church, Virginia. When he was young, he volunteered as a firefighter in Falls Church and later in Vienna, Fairfax County's first and oldest fire department, becoming their Assistant Chief. During World War II, he served in the Air Force Reserve as an aircraft mechanic at National Airport in Washington, D.C. where one of his duties was readying the plane that carried FDR to Yalta. In August of 1940 he married the love of his life, Marjorie Lou Waggoner of Vienna, Virginia where they had four children and began their commercial painting business of 28 years, Wilmar Contractors, Inc. In the 1960's, they moved their residence to Fauquier County Virginia where they lovingly restored "Belle Grove" circa 1780 near Paris, Virginia to it's original glory.

Survivors include his loving wife of 69 years, Marjorie; four daughters, Janet, Susan, Sandy and Mary; 14 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren.

The family will receive friends from 3:00-5:00 P.M. & 7:00-9:00 P.M. Friday, November 20, 2009 at Pierce Funeral Home, 9609 Center Street, Manassas. Funeral services will be held 2:00 P.M. Saturday, November 21, 2009 at Manassas Assembly of God, 11500 New Life Way, Bristow, Virginia with Pastors Scott Leib and Tom Moore officiating. Interment will follow at Marshall Cemetery, Marshall, Virginia.
