January 10, 1931 - July 7, 2018

Ida Mae Jones entered eternal life on July 7, 2018 at Prince William hospital. She was born to John and Fannie Harrison in Evening Shade Arkansas January 10, 1931. She and her 7 siblings; David, Jimmy, Billy, Wendell, Ben, Larry, and Glinda, learned the value of hard work as the children of share croppers during the depression. She moved to Washington DC when she was 18 years old and became a secretary for the US government. It was there that she met the love of her life and husband of 68 years, Elmer S. Jones Jr. U.S.N.

Ida was a stay at home mother until her children were in their early teens and then was employed by Prince William County schools where she was the head secretary at Yorkshire Elementary School. Her kindness and big smile touched the lives of thousands of children, teachers and administrators at Yorkshire, and later in her career, Sinclair, and Sudley Elementary Schools. She was often described as the “heart” of the school and remembered for her efficiency, generosity, and beautiful blue eyes.

Ida was a devoted mother to two daughters, and a doting grandmother to five grandchildren, 8 great grandchildren, and 3 great, great grandchildren.
