JACK L. BUCH, age 81 of Gainesville, Virginia departed this life on Wednesday, November 23, 2011 at his home after a heroic battle with cancer. He leaves behind to cherish his memory his devoted wife of 62 years, Betty; his daughter Paula Henegar, son-in-law, Hal Henegar who both loved him dearly and one granddaughter along with other relatives and many wonderful friends. He will be greatly missed by all. Early in his life, Jack left his hometown of Lancaster, PA to serve in the United States Marine Corps. In 1951 he joined the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) in Washington, D.C. After assignments in Robbery, Homicide, SOD, Internal Affairs, and Traffic, among others, he retired in 1975 as Inspector of MPD 7D. He was a graduate of the 82nd Session of the FBI National Academy.

After retirement from the MPD, he went on to another distinguished executive career in the GSA Federal Protective Service. Throughout his life he maintained a deep and patriotic love for the Marine Corps and unwavering pride, respect and brotherhood for the Metropolitan Police Department.
