Jack Pearce Williams, age 74, of Manassas, VA passed away Friday, August 12, 2022. He was born on April 24, 1948 in Scranton, PA to Jack and Izola Williams. He attended Hammond High School in Alexandria VA, graduating in 1966. Jack attended Virginia Tech University. He married Gail Williams on December 4, 1972.

Jack served two years in the United States Army before being sworn into the United States Park Police Force in 1972. He spent 28 years as a member of the United States Park Police, 14 of which as a member of the Motor Unit. Jack retired in December 2000 as a Senior Private, Motor 5, and one of the Lead Motor Unit's Instructors. He will be sadly missed by his fellow Police brotherhood and those that he trained across the country.

Jack loved to be around his friends and family, sharing his love of Harley Davidsons, Hunting, Fishing, Camping, and NASCAR racing events. But Jack's true love was spending time with his two grandchildren, Turner and Elise. The laughter and enjoyment between the three of them were contagious.
