Jacqueline McArdle Lee

Jacqueline M Lee died suddenly from an apparent heart attack at home on September 23, 2019. Jacque went to high school at St Xavier Academy in Latrobe Pennsylvania. She continued her education at Seton Hill University in Greensburg Pennsylvania graduating with a BA degree with a major in biology. Her first job after graduation was a lab assistant at the University of Pittsburgh Hospital. Jacque decided to switch to teaching by enrolling in an internship at Greensburg Salem High School that earned a Master's Degree in Education from the University of Pittsburgh. After completing the masters program, she taught biology at Keystone Oaks High School [n Dormont, Pennsylvania for five years. In 1969 she married Dick Lee and followed him to Philadelphia while he completed the final year of his MBA at the Wharton School. During this time, Jacquie taught science at the Nether Providence Middle School. Dick's first job out of graduate school was in Boston, MA. Jacquie taught science at the Stoneham Middle school. Dick's job then carried them to Camp Hill Pennsylvania where her sons Richard Jr and John were born..

Dick's job moved them to Columbus, Ohio, then back to Camp Hill, and finally to Fairfax County Virginia. Jacque returned to the classroom and taught science in Fairfax County Middle Schools for fifteen years. The three years before she retired, Jacquie became the Middle School Science Coordinator for Fairfax County. In this position, she developed the science curriculum for

all 26 Fairfax County Middle Schools. She also served on the Virginia State Committee that wrote the Science Standards of Learning for all middle schools in the state of Virginia. In addition, Jacquie took a team of students to the National Science Fair where they won the 1st place prize.

Jacquie retired in 2002. Jacquie and Dick traveled extensively. She also spent several years in retirement mentoring new teachers. They lived close to their two sons, their wives Jenny and Blaire and their grandchildren.. She especially enjoys spending time with her three grandchildren - Greg, Becca, and Jackson. Jacquie is also survived by her brother Dennis McArdle and sisters Jan McArdle and Chele McArdle.

Jacquie was born in Greensburg PA, the eldest child of Edwin Leo McArdle and Genevieve Kelley McArdle.
