



James "Welby" Carter

April 23, 1949 - December 27, 2024

James Welby Carter ("Welby"), age 75, passed away on Friday, December 27, 2024, in his home in Beaufort, South Carolina. He was born in Washington, D.C., on April 23, 1949, to Oscar and Amy Norine Carter, who predeceased him in death. He was also predeceased by his brother, Walter R. Carter, in 2009.

Most of his life was spent in Nokesville, Virginia, before moving to Beaufort, South Carolina in 2019. He was drafted into the United States Marine Corps in 1969 and served a tour in the Vietnam War as a mortarman. After returning from war, he married Lois Anders in 1970, and they later welcomed a daughter, Amy. Welby worked in the HVAC industry and started his own business in 2000 which continued until his retirement in 2018.

Welby loved tending his garden and sharing his vegetables with friends and neighbors. He especially liked deer hunting with friends. Some of his favorite pastimes were hanging out in his garage, watching NASCAR, Gunsmoke, the Andy Griffith Show and Judge Judy, and listening to bluegrass music.

Surviving are his wife, Lois, of Beaufort, South Carolina; his daughter, Amy Munda, and son-in-law, Randall Munda, of Beaufort, South Carolina; granddaughters, Karly Munda of Beaufort, South Carolina, and Kaitlin Johnson (Alex) of Pensacola, Florida; and a great grandchild expected in

August. Also surviving are his brothers, Warren Carter (Carole) of Parkersburg, West Virginia, and Donald Carter of Lynchburg, Virginia.
