James Workman Hendley, age 86, of Manassas, Virginia passed away Monday, January 23, 2017 at Westminster of Lakeridge.

He was born on October 11, 1930 in Spartanburg, SC the son of the late James and Mabel (Mitchell) Hendley. He graduated from Syracuse University, then served as an officer in the U.S. Army in Korea before returning to Syracuse to earn his law degree.

He worked for the Department of Defense first at the Fuel Center in Richmond, then in Alexandria at Cameron Station before receiving an appointment to the GSA Board of Contract Appeals as an Administrative Judge.
