March 3, 1949 - November 15, 2019

James (Jim) J. Herzog, 70, of Bristow, Virginia, was born on March 3, 1949, in Lewis Memorial Maternity Hospital, Chicago, Illinois to the late John Henry and Joanna Rose (nee Vidovic) Herzog and passed away on Friday, November 15, 2019.

Jim was the beloved husband of 47 years to Marianne (nee Stanish) Herzog; loving father of James J. Herzog, Jr., Matthew T. (Calley) Herzog, and Jillian C. Herzog; proud and loving grandfather of Gavin M., Elizabeth L. and Anna C. Herzog. Jim was preceded in death by his sibling, Joseph E.

Jim was a decorated combat Veteran having served a combined 32 years in the US Armed Forces. He was awarded a Bronze Star and a Purple Heart serving in Vietnam with the US Army's 82nd and 101st Airborne Divisions. He retired as First Sergeant of the 459th USAF Clinic at Andrews Air Force Base. Jim continued his dedication to his country as a Federal Civil Servant having retired with 35 years service ending his career with the United States Marshals Service. He was an avid sports fan who faithfully followed the Chicago White Sox and Chicago Bears.
