James "Jimmy" Edward McNeil, Jr., 51, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 2, 2018 at the Adler Center in Aldie, VA.

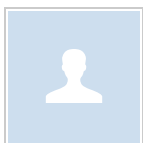
