James R. "Bob" Saul, 94, of Woodbridge, Virginia, died on June 4th, 2024. He was born in Roanoke County, Virginia on April 22, 1930. He grew up in the city of Roanoke, Virginia and graduated from Jefferson Senior High School in 1949.

Bob served on active duty in the United States Air Force from February 2, 1951 to December 10, 1953, achieving the rank of Staff Sergeant. Subsequently, he served in the United States Air Force Reserve from December 10, 1953 to December 10, 1958, receiving an honorable discharge.

He received a Bachelors of Arts degree from Roanoke College in 1957 and a Juris Doctor degree from the University of Richmond Law School in 1969.

Bob was employed by Allstate Insurance Company as a District Claims Manager in Richmond, Virginia. He was also employed as an Assistant City Attorney in Richmond, Virginia and was then City Attorney in Danville, Virginia beginning in November of 1985 and retiring from that position in May of 1997.

He married Mary Bernice Crook in 1959 and they were married for more than 61 years. They had one son, James Matthew Saul.

Bob was preceded in death by his father, Colonel William Saul; mother, Edith Hodges Saul; brothers, Gordon Elliott Saul

and Ronald Dexter Saul; and his loving wife Mary Crook Saul.
