Jan Marie Stanton was born in Columbus, Ohio on May 20, 1941. She was the only child of Edgar Schlaechter and Juanita Denson. Jan serendipitously met her husband, Roland (Ron) Stanton, at a pizza place following Easter Mass in 1958 and the two married on December 23, 1961 in Columbus. They had two daughters, Kimberly (Kim) in 1978, and Meghan in 1979, and eventually settled in Manassas, VA. Jan and Ron were happily married for 58 years.

Jan was deeply devoted to her family. One of her great joys was spoiling her grandsons, Miles and Jack. Her happiest times were always when she was together with her whole family.

Jan loved all animals and donated frequently to various animal rescue and conservation groups. She was an avid news watcher and could tell you everything going on in the world, as well as exactly why your political opinions were wrong if they differed from hers. Jan will be remembered for her fierce love and loyalty to her family, her ability to tell it like it is, her quick wit, and her never-ending appreciation of good conversation.

After a life well lived, Jan passed away peacefully surrounded by family on February 2, 2020 at Novant Health Prince William Medical Center. She is preceded in death by her parents, Edgar and Juanita, and many beloved dogs

and cats who were no doubt waiting for her with tails wagging. She is survived by her husband, Ron; her daughters, Kim Stanton and Meghan Cioletti and her husband, Paul; and her grandsons, Miles and Jack.
