JANE GROFF AUGUSTINE, age 65 died suddenly Monday, July 20, 2009, at her home in Gainesville, Virginia.

She was born February 4, 1944 in Confluence, Pennsylvania, daughter of the late William and Margaret Groff. Jane moved to Arlington, Virginia in 1962 from Confluence after graduating from Turkeyfoot Valley Area High School. She joined the Central Intelligence Agency in 1962 and retired in 2001.
