



## Jane Shutlock

April 7, 1935 - July 13, 2013

Jane Marie Shutlock, 78, of Manassas, VA, passed away on July 13, 2013 at the Fairfax Nursing Center from complications caused by acute myeloid leukemia. She was the widow of Michael Andrew (Mickey) Shutlock. Born in Schenectady, NY, on April 7, 1935, she was preceded in death by her parents, James and Genevieve Haggerty; a brother, Richard Haggerty; and a sister, Joan Lipscomb.
