



## Janice Marie Flint

June 28, 1936 - September 5, 2025

Janice Marie Webb Flint entered into the Lord’s presence on September 5, 2025 at the age of 89. Born on June 28, 1936, in JenkinJones, West Virginia, Janice was the third child of seven born to the late Maude and Ernest Webb. Janice cherished her parents and each of her siblings, whom she was known to lovingly tease with her quick wit. A graduate of Gary High School, Class of 1954, Janice went on to meet her forever sweetheart, Howe Reese "Mike" Flint, the “most handsome West Virginia coal-truck driver” who passed through her hometown of JenkinJones and “swept her off her feet”; the two married on May 28, 1954. Together, they built a life anchored in love, faith, and family. They found great pride and joy with the birth of their son, Michael Flint, who remained the apple of Janice’s eye.

Janice dedicated her life to serving others, first as a real estate agent beginning in the early 1970’s, and later as a highly-talented, yet perhaps strict, substitute teacher at Brentsville District Middle-Senior High. She found a treasured role when she assumed the title of “Mawmaw” to her three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. She poured love, wisdom, and joy into their lives, never missing a birthday party, road trip, or chance to spend time together. She shared some of her fondest memories around dinner tables where she adored hosting numerous Christmas parties with family.

Janice was a faithful member of Emmanuel Baptist Church in Manassas, VA, for over 60 years, where she joyfully served in many roles from Sunday School teacher to soprano in the church choir. She shared the love of Christ with everyone she met. In recent years she became a member of Manassas Baptist Church. Her sweet spirit, compassionate heart, and infectious sense of humor brought joy to all she met.

Janice is survived by her devoted son, Michael R. Flint of Nokesville, VA; her grandchildren, Joshua M. Flint (wife Mindy) of Chantilly, VA; Adam W. Flint of Osceola, FL; her namesake, Ashley Marie Flint of Cloverdale, VA; her great-grandchildren, Gavin Flint, Layla Flint, Logan Flint, and Jordy Clark; her brother Bob Webb of Bozeman, MT; as well as her sister, Helen Webb of Alexandria, VA; along with many nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends, including her loyal friend of 51 years, Susan Pennycuff.

Janice was preceded in death by her husband of 61 years, Howe Reese "Mike" Flint; parents, Ernest Webb and Maude Webb; brother, Donald Webb; sister, Peggy Webb Sapin; sister Nancy Webb Moore; and brother, Bill Webb; all whom she deeply loved and longed to be reunited with in heaven.

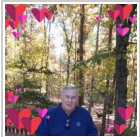
