Janice Eugenia Parr Novak died on July 28, 2012 at The Virginian Continuing Care Retirement Community in Fairfax, Virginia after an extended illness. She lived with her husband of 49 years and 8 months. She resided in Manassas, Virginia.

Born in Alma, Georgia, she was the daughter of the late Agnes Cynthia Johnson Parr and Lemuel Eugene Parr of Alma, Georgia. They moved to Henry Ford's plantation at Richmond Hill, Georgia where her father was employed and eventually made their home in Virginia. She was a graduate of Mount Vernon High School class of 1957 and attended Mary Washington University. In 1960, she began her business career as a staff assistant in the dental office of Dr. A. Paret. 1966 brought a change in employment; she accepted a position at the IBM Corporation's Government, Education and Marketing (GEM) Headquarters in Washington, DC. She transferred to the IBM Facility in Manassas, Virginia in 1969. She was employed in various positions as an Administrative Manager and a Staff Assistant to a Third Level Manager and retired after 25 years of service.

She and her husband John David Novak were married in Alexandria, Virginia at Saint Mary's Catholic Church on November 10, 1962. She is survived by her husband.
