Jeanne Fowler, 94, of Manassas, VA passed away peacefully on September 23, 2020 with family by her side. She was preceded in death by her late husband William Stanley Fowler; they were married for 68 years. She is survived by her three daughters Maureen Sisti (Jack Williams), Michele (Jason) Jacobson and Melanie (Chuck) Dolan and four grandchildren, Ashley, Aaron, Meredith and Tyler. Jeanne was preceded in death by her parents Norma Crain and William Faust and her sister Norma, brother Reggie and half-sister Nancy.

Jeanne Fowler grew up in Parole, Maryland before moving to Arlington, Virginia to work as a secretary in the Pentagon during World War II. Jeanne and Stan were married in 1947 and moved to Virginia Hills in Alexandria, Virginia in 1952 to accommodate their growing family. They were active members of Cameron United Methodist Church. She was a Girl Scout leader for many years which started the family on camping adventures. She was a sales representative for Beauty Counselor, a cosmetics company which later became Vanda Cosmetics. Her hat collection began when she attended and hosted hat parties in the 1960s. Her love of hats resurfaced in recent years as part of her signature style.

In 1977 they moved to Woodbine Woods in Manassas, Virginia. They became active members of Grace United Methodist Church where they founded the

50+ club, a social club. She enjoyed attending weekly bible study sessions where her wit was always welcome. Jeanne was an avid gardener and could be seen spending hours in her beautiful yard as recently as this spring. She was a charter member of the Woodbine Woods Garden Club where she was honored last year for her service. She was also active with the Virginia Wildflower Society.
