Jeffrey Ray Sobczak, age 54 of Manassas, VA died at Adler Center For Caring on Sunday, October 26, 2014.

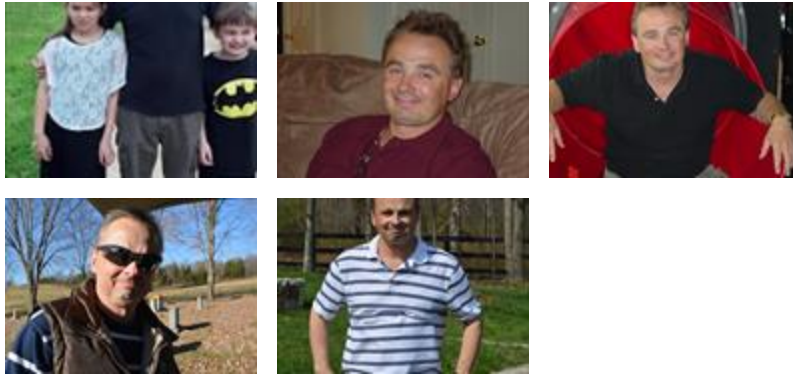
