Gerald Hart “Jerry” Gregory, age 86 of Manassas, Va died on June 5, 2021 at Manassas Health and Rehab Center.

Jerry was born on October 29, 1934 in Prince William County, VA, son of the late John Lawrence Gregory and Mary Virginia Strode Gregory.

Jerry was the owner of Gregory Florist and Gifts for 39 years, retiring in 2015. He was a graduate of Virginia Commonwealth University and has a Master’s degree from James Madison University. Prior to opening the floral shop, he was a math teacher in Prince William County Schools for five years and was employed with the Prince William County government for 10 years serving twice as a temporary replacement for the county executive.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by brothers, John Oliver Gregory, William Elwood Gregory, James Lawrence Gregory and his sister Mariam Gregory Dvorak.
