JERRY F. HAWKS, age 69 of Nokesville, Virginia died Friday, January 1, 2010 at St. Mary's Hospital, Richmond, Virginia.

Mr. Hawks started with the Virginia State Police and after 33 years of combined law enforcement service, retired from the Prince William County Police Department in 1995. Mr. Hawks was one of the original members of the Prince William County Police Department from its inception in 1970.
