Joan Walters Leggett, was born on November 25, 1924, in London, England. She was the daughter of Kate Collins Walters and Charles Roland Walters.

Growing up in war torn London, she was studying to be a concert pianist at the London Royal Conservatory. While serving the war effort, she met and married the love of her life, Joseph S. Leggett, who was serving as a Lieutenant Colonel in the U.S. Air Force.

They settled in Manassas in 1950. Joan was very active in the community. She served as President of the Manassas Jr. Woman's Club and the Manassas Woman's Club; also serving the Prince William Hospital Auxiliry as a volunteer in the Pink Ladies Thrift Shop. She was a member of Trinity Episcopal Church.

Joan is survived by her two daughters, Sheron (Rich) Seraydarian and Jacquelyn Snyder; her grandchildren, Bennett (Lynn) Dunn, Byron (Joanna) Dunn, Reid (Mary) Dunn, Ree Snyder, and Meredith (Jeff) Fox. Additionally, she is survived by nine great grandchildren.

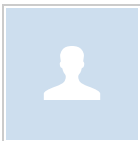
