JOHN ROBERT BEAHM, age 95 passed away Sunday, March 13, 2016 at his home in Nokesville, Virginia.

Mr. Beahm was born August 28, 1920 in Nokesville, son of the late George Wiley and Annie Alverta Early Beahm. He was also preceded in death by his loving wife, Aliene Nolley Beahm. He was a lifelong member of the Nokesville Church of the Brethren, a rural letter carrier for the U.S. Postal Service, a part time farmer and an avid barbershop singer and longtime member of the Bull Run Troubadour Barbershop Chorus.
