John Roy Doggett, age 86, of Manassas, Virginia passed away Monday, February 20, 2017 at Manassas Health and Rehab Center.

He was born on October 21, 1930 in Vienna, Virginia, the son of the late Roy W and Margaret E Doggett. With his wife, Joan, he owned Doggett's Realty and managed their properties in Manassas.

John was a man of many interests and talents. He was an active member in Experimental Aviation Association (EAA Chapter 186) who taught aluminum aviation welding at the International Convention of EAA in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. He held numerous world records in aviation speed. An avid hunter and fisherman, he was an active member of the Izaak Walton League and enjoyed hunting season at the cabin in Monterey, Virginia. He flew radio control model planes. He built 7.5-gauge model trains, and communicated far and wide as a licensed ham radio operator. He was a beekeeper; a pigeon racer; a collector of antique cars, hit miss engines; and the man could clean out a buffet line.

Survivors include his wife of 60 years, Joan M Doggett; two daughters, Donna Doggett Mack of Virginia Beach, Virginia, and Diane E Watson of Manchester, New Hampshire; one granddaughter, Alexandra E Watson of Charlotte, North Carolina.
