JOHN DAVID KLINE, JR., age 70, a lifelong resident of Manassas, Virginia died Thursday, April 22, 2010 at Inova Fairfax Hospital.

Mr. Kline was born August 2, 1939 in Manassas, Virginia, son of the late John David and Daisy Virginia (Mauck) Kline.
