He received the divine call to the ministry in 1980 to the Manassas, VA Church of God where he pastored the congregation he loved until retirement in 2021. 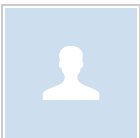

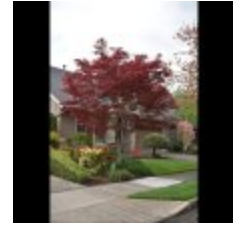

“Bro John Wilcoxon, so loving, sweet, kind, gentle, patient he exhibited Galatians 5:22-23. When I first got saved in 1985, the Wilcoxon family took me in almost like a daughter, my family and I were always at their table during Thanksgiving each year. Later I felt bad for calling him those hours, but he was so kind and never reprimanded me for it, I am glad he was patient. Because of him my husband got saved and Bro Wilcoxon has used him in the kingdom. Bro Wilcoxon will be missed greatly, he was like a father to me and my family, and to the Church of God all around the world, he affected many, no word can really express him except he was Church of God all the way, he was a great influencer, plus a great example, he has passed the truth on to carry until God call us on.
