John Arthur Yohe, Jr. (Jack), age 63, passed away on Monday, May 29, 2017 at Haymarket Medical Center in Haymarket, VA.

He was born on September 18, 1953 in Allentown, PA to the late John Arthur and Anna (Gabler) Yohe.

Jack loved playing and coaching baseball. In his younger years, he actively coached Little League and Babe Ruth in McLean, VA, Herndon, VA and Fort Lauderdale, FL. Many young baseball players attribute their success in baseball to Jack's knowledge of the game. Next to baseball, Jack was an avid golfer and active in the Ned's Devine Golf Society, of which he was a founding member. During the last 30 years, Jack Yohe served as a Sr. Vice President with the Mistral Group, located at Bethesda, MD.
