Jonathan Craig Spitler passed away on May 31, 2025 at Prince William Hospital after 6 days in the Intensive Care Unit. He died from a heart attack and numerous seizures.

“Jon” was born in Warrenton on July 17, 1953 to Ernest Clark Spitler, Jr and Jeanne Basgier Spitler of Manassas. He attended Osbourn High School and graduated from the Class of 1971. He attended Virginia Tech and then graduated from the Medical College of Virginia with a Pharmacy degree in 1976. During his career he worked at many different pharmacies including Cocks’s Pharmacy, Spitler’s Pharmacy, Robinson’s Pharmacy, Peoples, and CVS.

Jon’s hobbies included sports, baseball cards, coins, and Civil War history.
