Jose Gerard Evangelista - known as Gerard by those close to him - of Manassas, VA passed away on October 23, 2024.

He was born in the Philippines to Leonardo Evangelista and Esperanza Rebolledo on March 19, 1968. He migrated to the United States in 1987 at the age of 19 with his parents. Gerard graduated high school from San Sebastian College, Manila and started working towards his college degree in Engineering but was interrupted due to the family's US migration. They initially lived in Minnesota but decided to move to Virginia in 1988.

He started his career in retail, then transitioned into the airline industry. The last 15 years of his career were in the banking industry.

Gerard had a happy childhood and was a star player for a basketball community league. He was the youngest and only boy in the family, so he was showered with so much love and attention from everyone. He loved to sing but was a better dancer. He was funny, generous, cool, and always end up being the life of the party. He never failed to exude laughter from people with his antics and funny jokes.

He met the love of his life in 1998 at a welcome party for her in Virginia and they got married on May 10, 2003.

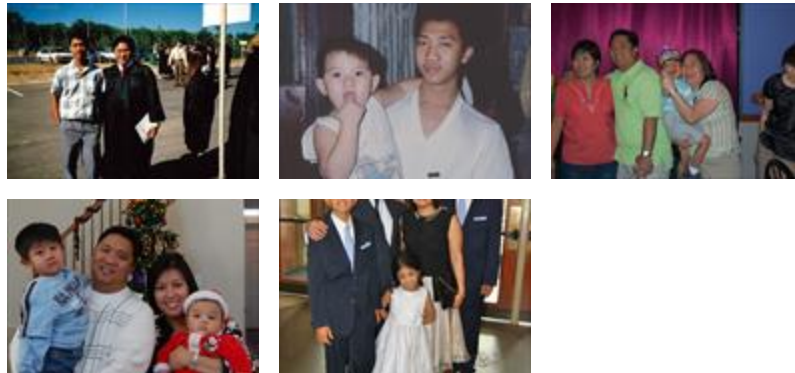
