



Joseph Michael Grimberg

February 6, 1976 - January 31, 2025

Joseph Michael Grimberg, 48, of Manassas, Virginia, went home to God after a brief illness on January 31, 2025, with his parents and most of his siblings at his side.

Joey was born on February 6, 1976, in Silver Spring, Maryland, the first-born child of Peter and Carol Grimberg. At the age of five, he was diagnosed with Duchenne muscular dystrophy. He grew up in Frederick and Walkersville, Maryland. He attended Elizabeth Ann Seton grade school in Emmitsburg, Maryland. He coached younger boys in baseball though he couldn't play competitively himself, and his players became all-stars.

Joey began high school at Walkersville High School. After ninth grade he wanted to attend a Catholic school. The Catholic high schools in the Maryland area at that time were not able to accommodate a handicapped student, but a friend of the family suggested that his parents investigate Seton Junior-Senior High School in Manassas, Virginia. Mr. Grimberg and Joey visited Seton in the summer of 1991, and he entered Seton that fall.

Graduating from Seton in 1994, Joey went on to Northern Virginia Community College, where he obtained an associate's degree. He later received a B.A. degree in communications from George Mason University.

When Joey was first diagnosed with Duchenne M.D., the life expectancy was

twenty years. He lived over twice that long, a life filled with a loving family, many friends, a strong Catholic Faith, a devotion to Our Lady and the Rosary, and many interests and activities. Joey enjoyed playing chess, enthusiastically following his favorite Washington sports teams, the Redskins (Commanders) and Nationals, and discussing politics. He had a podcast with his friend Harold, who died about a year ago. Despite the harsh realities of his disease, Joey kept a positive attitude and brought joy to all who knew him. His deep Faith was an inspiration to his family and his friends.

Joey is survived by his parents, Peter and Carol Grimberg; his brothers, Justin and Michael; his sisters, Mary, Rachel, and Anna; and nine nieces and nephews.

The wake will take place at Seton School, 9311 Maple Street, Manassas, on Monday, February 10, 5:00-7:00 PM. The requiem Mass will be celebrated by Father Gregory Thompson at All Saints Catholic Church in Manassas at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, February 11, the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.
