



Joseph Conrad Pado

July 25, 1936 - January 7, 2017

Joseph Conrad Pado, age 80, passed away on January 7, 2017 at INOVA Fairfax Hospital in Falls Church, VA.

He was born on July 25, 1936 in Boston, Massachusetts to the late Theodore Alexander and Mary Frances (Jamros) Pado.

After Joe graduated from Cumberland High School in Cumberland RI, he joined the army and spent three years in Beppu, Japan and Fort Campbell, KY. He served 30 years with the US Department of State and its Foreign Service, where he was stationed in Karachi, Pakistan; The Hague, Netherlands; Kathmandu, Nepal; Montreal, Canada; Rome, Italy and Washington, DC before retiring in 1995. Post-retirement, he lived in Vienna VA, Denver CO, and most recently in Haymarket VA. Joe loved to travel and experience foreign cultures, play golf and bridge, attend concerts, the symphony and opera, and read substantive books. Most of all, he enjoyed following his children and grandchildren in their lives.

Predeceased by his parents; two sisters: Felice Blazin and Frances Francoeur; one brother: Henry Pado.
