Joseph Carman Quantrille, 67, of Bristow, VA, passed away, Friday, June 15, 2012 after a long battle with pancreatic cancer. Joe was born in Washington DC on September 13, 1944. He was the son of the late Howard B. and Florence O. Quantrille. Joseph graduated from Suitland High School and received a Bachelor of Science in Administration of Justice from American University and a Master of Arts in Forensic Sciences from Antioch University.
