Judy Elaine McWilliams, 77, of Manassas, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family on February 23, 2022 after a long battle with non-alcoholic liver cirrhosis. Judy now sleeps peacefully, awaiting Jesus to come and wake her to eternal life when He comes on the last day.

Judy was born February 6, 1945 in Washington D.C. and grew up in Fairfax, Virginia where she lived until moving to Manassas, Virginia in 1977. Judy graduated from Fairfax High School in 1963.
