September 27, 1946 - April 21, 2016

Judy Mae Miller, age 69, of Manassas, VA passed away Thursday, April 21, 2016 at Inova Fairfax Hospital after a courageous battle from complications from hip surgery.

She was born on September 27, 1946 in Independent Hill, VA, the daughter of the late Franklin and Dorothy (Norman) Keys and 1965 graduate of Osbourn High School. After a brief career in the Federal Government, she worked for Prince William County Schools for over 30 years, known best as the secretary of Mullen Elementary School. She was a longtime active member of the Manassas Baptist Church, and prior to that she was a member of the Bethel Lutheran Church, serving at both churches in many capacities such as choir, fellowship, worship and music, Sunday School and many other committees.

In 1990, she lost the love of her life, her husband, Eddie K. Miller, Sr. She is also preceded in death by two brothers, Frankie Keys and Herbie Keys.

She will be forever remembered by her charming smile, her love of Santas and all things Redskins, her wonderful cooking, and her service and dedication to the community, the Stonewall Jackson Volunteer Fire and Rescue, her students and staff in schools, her church family, and her large extended family in the Manassas area.

Survivors include her three children, Tammy Warner and husband Dave of Manassas, VA, Cheryl Scribner and husband Rob of Bristow, VA, Eddie Miller, JR and wife Deanna of Manassas, VA; one brother, Steve Keys of Caroline County, VA; seven grandchildren, Kym Lawrence and husband Mike, Brian Wilson and wife Sarah, Christian Wilson, Abby Miller, Eddie Miller, III, Madeline Miller and Khalil Holz; three great grandchildren, Ashley Lawrence, Kylie Lawrence and London Lawrence, and many in-laws, cousins, nieces, nephews, and the many she “adopted” into her family.
