Woodbridge, VA. – June Raye Williams, known to all as “Granny” 91, passed on Friday, 11/12/21 at Sentra Hospital. She was born 11/8/30 in Harrisonburg, VA., and was the daughter of the late Linden Franklin and Catherine Webster Holsinger.

Shortly after WWII, she married Billy L. Langston, and they would happily remain by each other’s side for over 50 years, until Parkinson’s took him in 2006. June was the Comptroller for several U.S. government offices, including the Departments of the Army, Air Force, and the Office of Naval Research. She retired in 1988 with over 30 years of service and earning multiple civilian awards for outstanding performance. She was a loyal member of the American Society of Military Comptrollers and co-founded/co-chaired the NOVA Parkinson’s support group in 1989. June was proud to be an 8th generation Virginian, who through her daughter, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, great-great grandson, and great-great-granddaughter saw 4 more generations added to that long legacy.

In addition to her parents, she was predeceased by her husband, Billy Williams, and her daughter Linda S. Williams Wood.
