December 30, 1944 - April 11, 2009

Katherine Barolet Brice, 64, passed away April 11, 2009 at her daughter's home in Haymarket, Virginia. She was surrounded by her daughter and son-in-law, Tawni and Brett , as well as her sister, Grace. Her grandson, Bryce was not present; however, he gave her much joy in the last months of her life. She had battled pancreatic cancer for the past 13 months.

She is survived by her daughter, Tawni Brice Schwemer, son-in-law, Brett T. Schwemer, and grandson, Bryce Connor Schwemer of Haymarket, VA. Other survivors include her father, John A.
