Kathryn (Kathi) Hall Siford, beloved wife, mother, and sister, passed from this life on Monday, April 13, 2020. A private family-only entombment will be on Friday, April 17, at Stonewall Memory Gardens in Manassas, VA officiated by Pastor Jeff Wilson of Bethel Lutheran Church.

A Celebration of Kathi's life will be held at a later date.

Kathi was born in Holden (Logan County), West Virginia, in 1946. She moved to Virginia after completing her education, spending her career with financial institutions (including banking and credit union management positions), where she was recognized for her outstanding service. Her interests included the performing arts, reading, Bible study, and social activities.

She attended Bethel Lutheran Church and St. Thomas United Methodist Church (both in Manassas VA).

She is preceded in death by her parents, Comfort and Emma Elizabeth Preece Hall (both of Mingo County, WV); also by a brother, Eugene Hall (of Delbarton, WV).

She is survived by her husband of 39 years, Duane Siford, of Gainesville, VA; daughter Dr. Kara Elizabeth Siford, also of Gainesville; and son Rex Toler, Jr.

She is also survived by a brother, Don Hall of Terre Haute, IN; and sisters Sue Long of Columbus, OH; Nancy Berkley of Bristow, VA; and Sharon Hall of Manassas, VA. In addition, she is survived by many nieces and nephews, all of whom she adored.
