Kaushalya (Koshi) Gursahaney, 84, passed away Thursday, February 14, 2019 in Fairfax, Virginia at Inova Fair Oaks hospital. She was born in Karachi, India and emigrated with her family to Calcutta after the partition. After marriage in 1958, she emigrated to the United States and raised a family in Louisville, KY, Columbus, OH, Middletown, NJ and Pittsburgh, PA.

She is survived by her husband, Kishin, her children, Suresh, Naren (Judy), and Shirin (Doug) and seven grandchildren, Kayla, Phillip, Sarina, Jason, Alisha, Steven and Nikhil. She is also survived by her sister Devi and her brother Pritam. She is preceded in death by her brother, Lachu.

Koshi worked in the healthcare field as a medical technologist, laboratory technician and phlebotomist. She was an accomplished homemaker, corporate wife, cook and seamstress, but her most remembered roles were as loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunty, and friend. Over the years, she cared for her aging in-laws and extended her home and love to family and friends from near and far.
