Kenneth "Scott" Bodman, 52, passed away on March 14, 2025, in Manassas, Virginia.

Born on November 23, 1972, in Rome, New York, Scott earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Montevallo. He later served with distinction in the United States Navy for nine years, achieving the rank of Lieutenant before receiving an honorable discharge.

Scott was a devoted father to his children—Nathaniel, Grace, Monica, Alexander, Annalise, and John Paul Bodman—and a beloved son to his mother, Threasa Kaye Bodman. He was predeceased by his father, Walter Kenneth Bodman III, and his sister, Amy Bodman.

A convert in early adulthood, Scott was Catholic and found strength in his beliefs. He had a passion for painting, cycling, and hunting—pursuits that brought him both joy and tranquility. Above all else, he cherished his family and held them close to his heart.
