January 20, 1938 - January 28, 2009

KENNETH MICHAEL CONCANNON, SR., age 71 of Bristow, Virginia died Wednesday, January 28, 2009 at his residence.

Mr. Concannon was a member of All Saints Catholic Church, Manassas, a member of the Knights of Columbus and the Ancient Order of Hibernians. He was very much involved in ProLife activities from 1972 until the present and was the first county director of Morris County New Jersey Right To Life. He worked as a youth counselor for the Vint Hill Youth group, was employed with the U.S. government for 30 years as a management analyst. He was an all around great Dad, Baseball Coach, Boy Scout leader and Cub Scout leader. Mr. Concannon wrote a monthly column for the Arlington Catholic Herald and a weekly column for the News Messenger (Journal Messenger/Potomac News) for 12 years.

He was preceded in death by his daughter, Amy Melissa Concannon in 1998 and his brother, Brian Concannon in 2000.

Survivors include his loving wife of 43 years, Charlene Joan Concannon; two sons, Kenneth Michael Concannon, Jr. and wife Amy of Burke, Virginia and Colin Michael Concannon and wife Carole Elizabeth of Alexandria, Virginia; one sister, Mary Stasia Concannon of Budd Lake, New Jersey and five grandchildren, Elizabeth Rebecca Sanie, Ian Concannon, Sky Concannon,

Brooke Concannon and Tess Concannon.
