



Kenneth Malamphy

February 5, 1928 - January 11, 2012

Kenneth Joseph Malamphy, age 83, passed away peacefully with family members by his side on January 11, 2012 at Fauquier Hospital in Warrenton, VA. He was also lovingly known as Kenny, Lamph and Paw Paw. He was born on February 5, 1928 in Houston, Texas, the son of the late geologist Mark Cyril Malamphy and Mary Clarke Malamphy. He was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean War, a purple heart recipient, and retired with 30 years of service from the U.S. Postal Service.

Growing up, Kenny spent many memorable days with relatives at a farm in Cumberland, Maryland. He was a track star in high school, graduating in 1948 from Little Rock High School in Little Rock, Arkansas. He boxed in the Golden Gloves competition and went on to graduate from the Corcoran School of Art. An outstanding cartoonist, he would often portray himself as "Sarge" and his alter-ego "Rags". He enjoyed art and cartooning throughout his life. As a young man he traveled to Africa, South America, Britain and Brazil, living and working for his father with the U.S. Bureau of Mines overseas. Upon returning to the states, he met his beloved Louise as they wrapped gifts together at the local Woodward & Lothrop's in Arlington, VA. He enjoyed fishing, raising racing pigeons, gardening and was an avid Redskins fan.

He is survived by his loving wife of 53 years, Louise Mae Malamphy; his sons Michael Neal Malamphy and wife Karen, and Kenneth (Rocky) Clarke

Malamphy and wife Janet; his grandchildren: Kimberly Malamphy, Jacob Malamphy and wife Vicki, Shane Malamphy, Heather Malamphy and Amanda Malamphy; great-granddaughter Hailey Malamphy, and numerous nieces, nephews, and relatives. He was also preceded in death by his sister Kathleen Malamphy and brother Mark C. Malamphy, Jr.
