Kenneth Maurice Robinson of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina died on September 14, 2023 at Conway Meical Center. He was born on December 11, 1941 in Washington, DC, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Oswald Robinson.

Kenneth attended Fairfax Hish School and graduated in 1960. After graduation he worked as an electrician prior to entering the United States Army. He did his AIT training at Fort Polk, Louisiana and received the Trainee of the Cycle Award after his basic training. He was an expert with the M1 Rifle and M14 Rifle. After serving in the military receiving the Vietnam Service Medal and receiving his honorable discharge, he worked as an electrician and received his Master Electrician License.
