



## Kevin Pell

KEVIN LAMAR PELL, age 43, passed away on Saturday, March 26, 2011 from complications of Diabetes.

Kevin was born in Arlington, VA on September 4, 1967 and lived his life in Fairfax, VA where he had many friends. During Kevin's school years he enjoyed playing soccer, baseball and racing BMX bikes. However, throughout his life his greatest passion was working on cars and auto racing. He worked with his father during his high school years in the family business.
