February 10, 1987 - January 24, 2009

Kevin Simpson, 21, of Lake Anna, Virginia, formerly of Manassas, passed away Saturday morning, January 24, 2009 as the result of an automobile accident in the city of Manassas.

Simpson was a 2005 graduate of Osbourn Park High School, Manassas where he lettered in football for four years and was Co-Captain of the team his senior year when he was named the team's MVP. Kevin was also named to the All District that year and to the Washington Post's All Regional Team. He also attended Germanna Community College in Fredericksburg.

He then moved to Lake Anna soon after his graduation where he was introduced to the real estate world. He earned his license in 2007 and became a Realtor, joining the firm of Lake Anna Island Realty. In addition to being an avid Washington Redskins fan, Kevin enjoyed both hunting and fishing.
